

# St Patrick's Day Door Wreath

Give your home a cheerful St Patrick's Day touch with this traditional burlap door wreath. Using just a few materials and your ScanNCut machine, you'll create this fun and festive project in no time!

**Time Required: 1.5 hours**

**Skill Level: All Levels**

## MATERIALS REQUIRED

- Brother ScanNCut (this project was created with the CM650W)
- Wire wreath form
- Burlap ribbon
- Burlap trim
- Styrofoam moss rocks
- Green ribbon
- 12"x12" light green cardstock
- 12"x12" darker green cardstock
- 2 pieces of wire (4" of 22 gauge wire)
- Low temp hot glue gun
- Fabric glue
- 3D adhesive foam squares
- Burlap dye ink



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## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Create the burlap wreath base.



Fold a piece of wire into a U shape and poke through a folded end of the burlap ribbon. Wrap the burlap end up and around the inside wire on the wreath base and secure in place.



Feed approximately 3 inches of burlap up through each frame opening



Scrunch the burlap in the frame together, turn the base over, and twist the remaining burlap ribbon 3 times.

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## INSTRUCTIONS: (CONT'D)



Repeat the process until the wire base is covered and then secure the end of the burlap ribbon with the remaining piece of wire.



Decorate the burlap wreath with burlap trim and ribbon as desired. Wrap and secure in place with a low temperature glue gun or fabric glue.

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## INSTRUCTIONS: (CONT'D)

- Using your ScanNCut, create cutouts to embellish the styrofoam moss rocks.



Using the pre-programmed fonts in your ScanNCut, create a cut document featuring your favourite St Patrick's Day words (we used FO-A010). Resize the words to fit on your styrofoam moss rocks. The words will be about 2 - 2.5 inches wide with varying heights.



Glue the letters to the styrofoam moss rocks and set aside to dry.

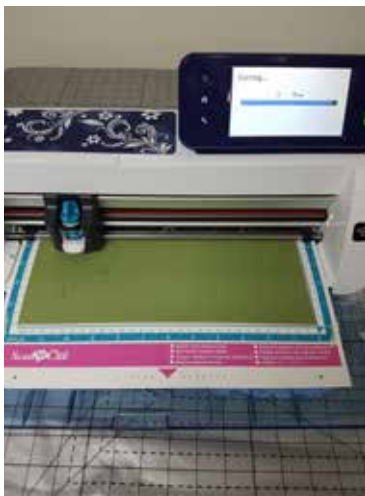


Once dry, arrange and adhere to the wreath with the low temperature glue gun.

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## INSTRUCTIONS: (CONT'D)

- Using the ScanNCut, create clover embellishments.



Cut 3 clovers (cut file AR-A028) approximately 3.5 inches wide and 3 clovers approximately 2.5 inches wide from the darker green cardstock. Then, cut 6 of the smaller 2.5 inch clovers from the light green cardstock.



Ink the edges of all the clover shapes and then attach one of the smaller clovers to each of the 3 larger clovers with the 3D adhesive foam squares. Shape the clover petals with your fingers to give them dimension.



Arrange and adhere to the wreath with the glue gun.



Hang your beautiful new wreath on your door to welcome friends and family into your home for St Patrick's Day.



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
